Even once people are referred for further tests for suspected cancer, they can face delays because:

- Multiple scans and tests are needed,
- Lack of administration and coordination capacity in diagnostic pathway,
- Delays in decision-making.

People with pancreatic cancer should have their diagnosis confirmed or ruled out within **21 days** of being sent for tests.
