The problem of low access to treatment rates

Only 30% of people with pancreatic cancer will receive any form of treatment

Pancreatic Cancer U K

Some factors which contribute to low access to treatment rates are:

- Delays in patients receiving a treatment decision plan,
- Lack of consistency in how patients are treated in specialist or local healthcare services,
- The current 62-day standard from referral to initiation of treatment which is too slow for people with pancreatic cancer.
