

Our case for faster treatment

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The problem of low access to treatment rates

Only **30%** of people with pancreatic cancer will receive any form of treatment

Some factors which contribute to low access to treatment rates are:

- Delays in patients receiving a treatment decision plan,
- Lack of consistency in how patients are treated in specialist or local healthcare services,
- The current 62-day standard from referral to initiation of treatment which is **too slow** for people with pancreatic cancer.

Our solutions to improve access to treatment

People with pancreatic cancer should start treatment within **21 days** of getting their diagnosis



Our solutions to improve access to treatment

Ensure **standardised treatment pathways** are in place, based on stage at diagnosis and tumour classification.
