

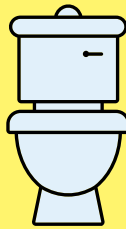
Most people can't name the symptoms of pancreatic cancer. Can you?



Indigestion



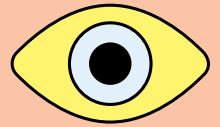
Tummy pain or back pain

Jaundice (yellow skin or eyes and itchy skin)

If you have any of these symptoms and you don't know why you have them, go to your GP or contact NHS 111. If you have jaundice, go to your GP or A&E straight away.

Remember that these symptoms could have more common causes.
