Team: Events Fundraising

Supervisor: A staff member from the Events Team – you will be given a name and contact details prior to the event

Minimum Age: 16 years - we welcome applications from people aged 16 or 17 years old. We just need your parent or guardian to complete and sign a consent form.

Location: events are in Brighton, Edinburgh, London and Newcastle, see application form for exact details

When: various dates between April – October 2026, see application form

Times: exact times will be confirmed with you and you can choose to a half or whole shift.

- Able to be at a cheer point for a few hours
- Lots of enthusiasm and energy

- This role involves standing for a few hours and no seating is available
