

## Clinical photoshoot volunteer

**Minimum Age:** 18

### Key details:

**Date:** 17th March 2026

**Time:** we will confirm the timings closer to the time, but the photoshoot will take place roughly between the hours of 9am and 6pm. You won't be required to stay for the full time – we can be flexible with your availability.

**Location:** Clatterbridge Cancer Centre – Liverpool, 65 Pembroke PI, Liverpool L7 8YA

**Getting to the hospital:** the hospital is accessible via public transport and car parking is available at Paddington Village car park which is a short walk from the hospital, and there is a shuttle bus too.

### About Pancreatic Cancer UK:

We are Pancreatic Cancer UK. We bring more breakthroughs through research, more change through campaigning, and more support through our expert nurses. Because people with pancreatic cancer need more than hope.

### The impact you'll have by volunteering:

Photography is a powerful tool to bring to life the services and support we offer to people affected by pancreatic cancer, as well as with health professionals. Your involvement in our photoshoot will ensure our photography features real people, creating authentic, meaningful connections with our audience and helping us to stand out.

### What will I be doing?

In the photos, we will ask you to take on the role of a patient and/or a loved one in a range of settings. This could include:

- Speaking to a health professional alone, as if in a clinical consultation
- Speaking to a health professional with another volunteer (representing a couple, friend, family member), as if in a clinical consultation
- Posing with another volunteer (representing a couple, friend, family member)
- Solo portraits looking at the camera and into the distance

Our aim is to capture photos that are as close to real life clinical scenarios as possible. There will be real health professionals taking part in the photoshoot as models. Please be mindful, they won't be available for individual consultation.

### Where the photos will be used:

The photos will primarily be used in the promotion of our support services and our health professional services. They will be used on our websites, email, social media, and other marketing activities. They will also be used for our publications and information for both print and web.

We will provide you with a consent form to sign which is an agreement for the photos to be used for 7 years from the date of the photoshoot. You can withdraw this consent at any time should you wish.

### Do I need any skills or attributes to do this role?

No specific skills or attributes are required for this role but as it is a photoshoot, you will need to be:

- Able to follow directions from the photographer

- Confident being in front of a camera
- Comfortable acting in a different role
- Happy to spend time waiting as others have their photos taken or settings are created

### **What should I wear?**

- You can wear whatever you would wear to a hospital appointment. This could be jeans and a jumper for example.
- We recommend wearing comfortable shoes.
- Please note that hair and make-up is not included so please arrive as you'd like to be photographed.

### **Equality, Diversity and Inclusion:**

We warmly welcome people of a range of genders, ethnicities, abilities and capabilities, and ages to take part. That's why in our form we have included some questions about you. This will ensure the participants we select for this project represent all communities affected by the disease and our photography reflects the diverse population of the UK. These fields in the form are optional and this data will be deleted after the photoshoot has taken place.

### **Accessibility:**

- The hospital is a busy, fast-paced environment. We will be taking photos in a meeting room and consultation room which will be quieter, but we will also be taking photos in the corridors and public spaces. If you dislike noise and busy environments, this may not be a suitable opportunity for you.

### **What you can expect from us:**

- We will provide you with a contact at the charity who will be your main point of contact.
- Further information about the plans for the photoshoot and your role.
- We'll provide a safe, non-judgemental space for you to be yourself in accordance with our commitment to Equality, Diversity Inclusion and Belonging.
- We will provide refreshments, snacks and lunch during the day.
- We'll reimburse reasonable travel and accommodation expenses (if travel there and back in the day isn't possible), in line with our Volunteer Expenses Policy. If you require support in arranging your travel, please let us know and we'll be happy to help.
